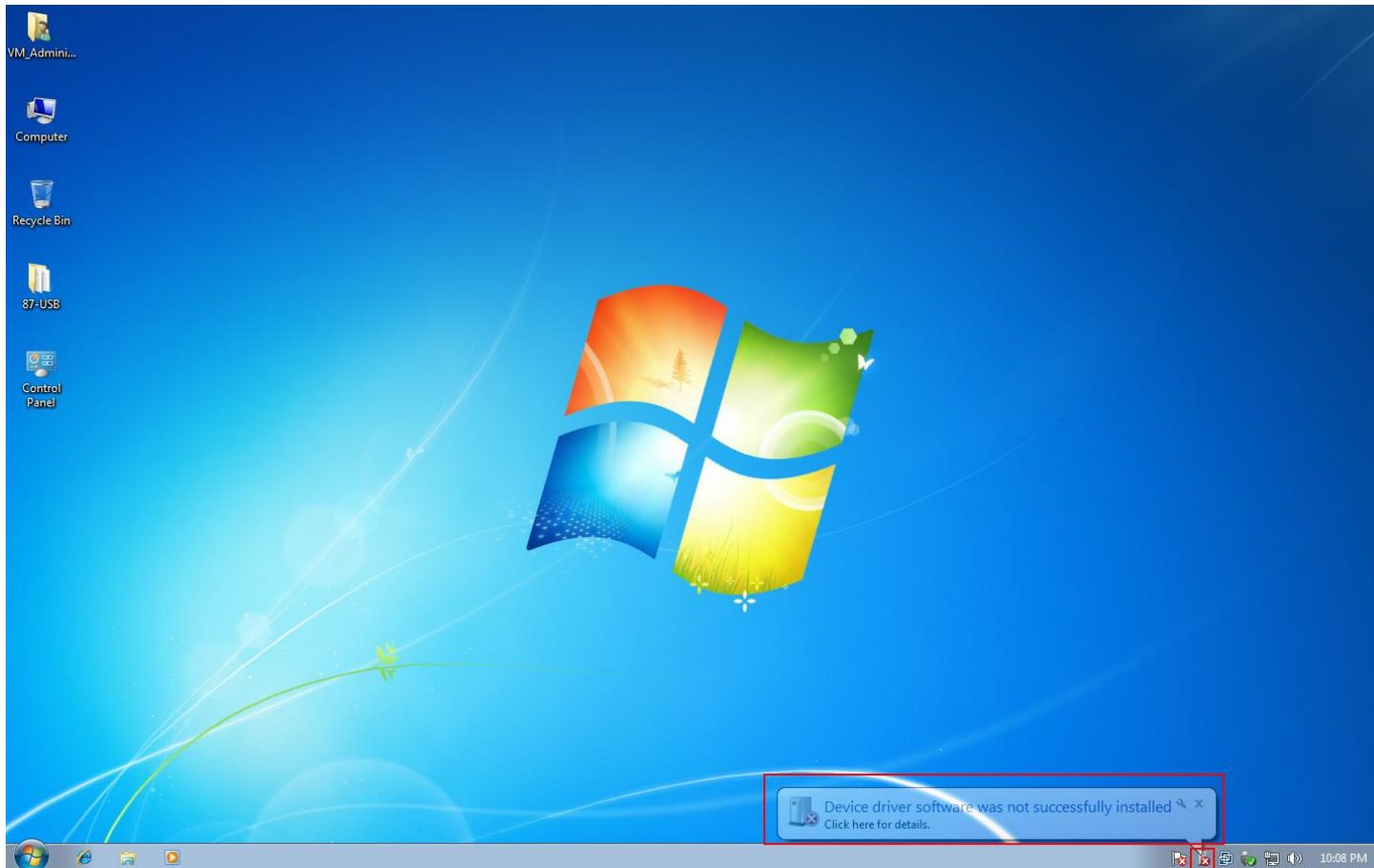
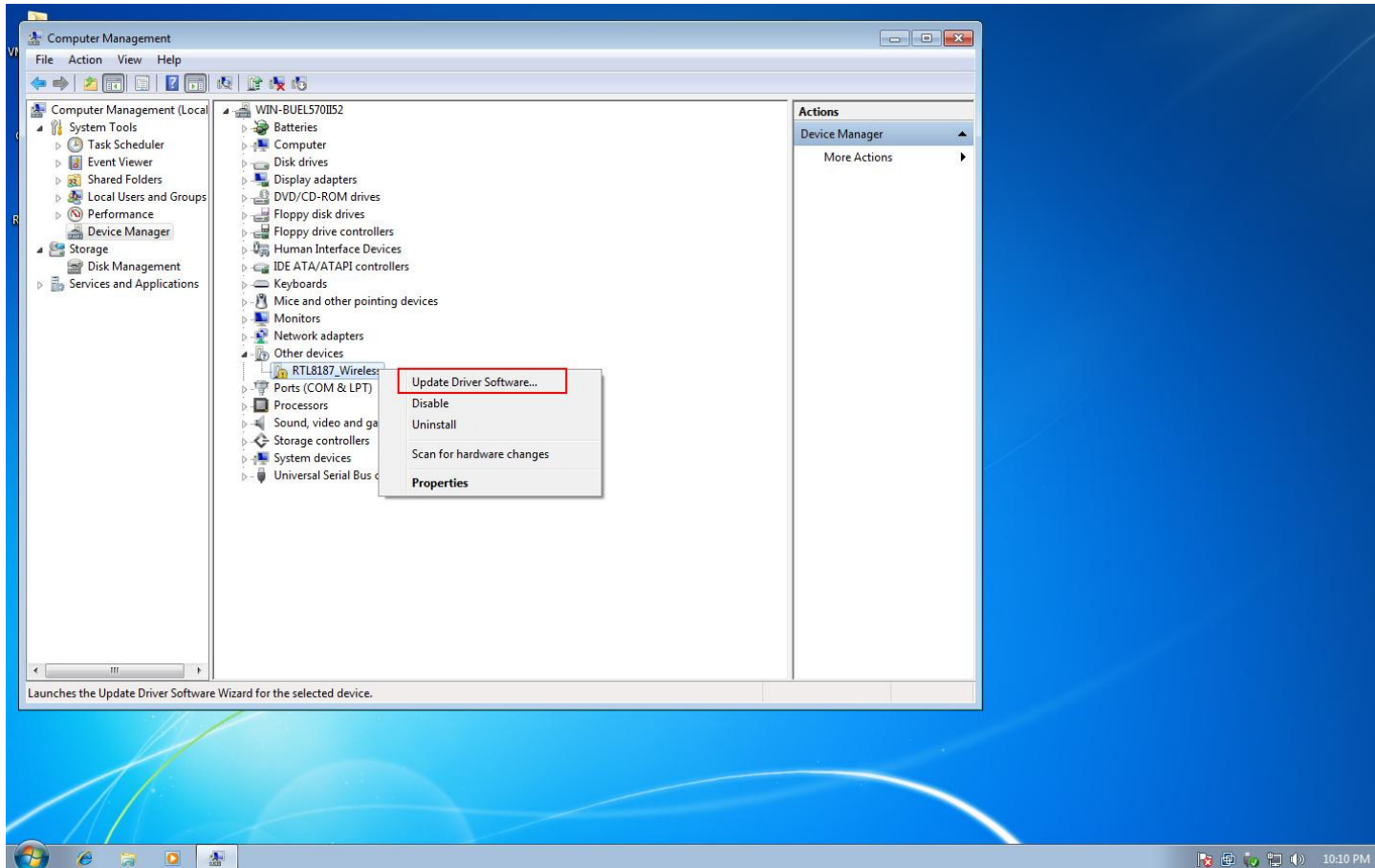


How to install RTL8187L driver on Windows 7

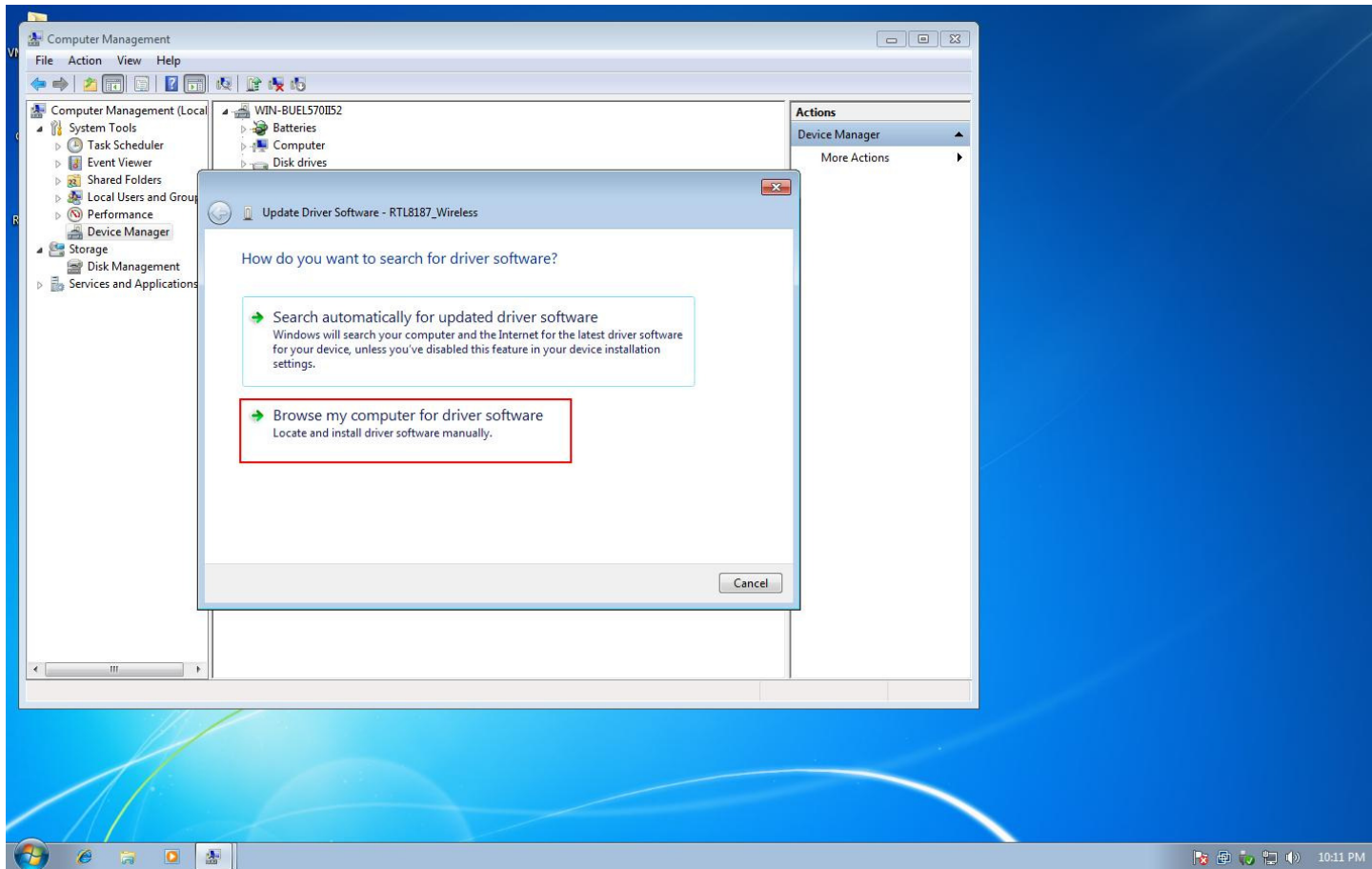
1. Download your copy of driver, store to a storage device. Extract the compressed archive. There will be an 87-USB folder created; drivers are stored in RTL8187 sub-folder.
2. Plug in your WLAN USB adapter, the system will try to install driver from its native drivers. A warning message will pop up and indicates the failure of driver installation.



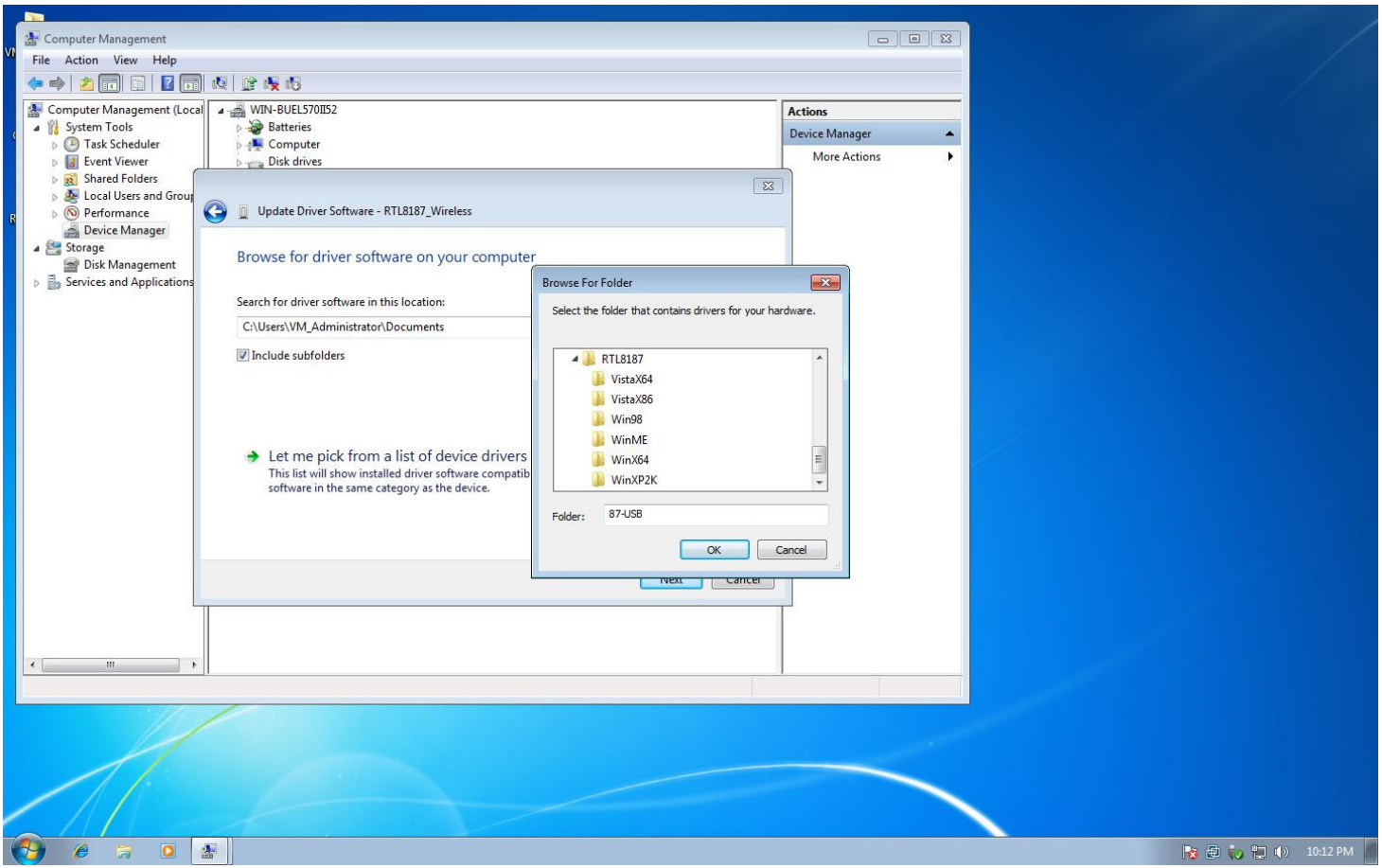
3. Open **"Device Manger"** to manually install the driver; right click on **"Computer"** icon then select **"Manage"**, a **"Computer Management"** windows will pop up and let you to manage your hardware. On **"Device Manager"**, **"Other devices"**, right click on **"RTL8187_Wireless"**, then choose **"Update Driver Software"**



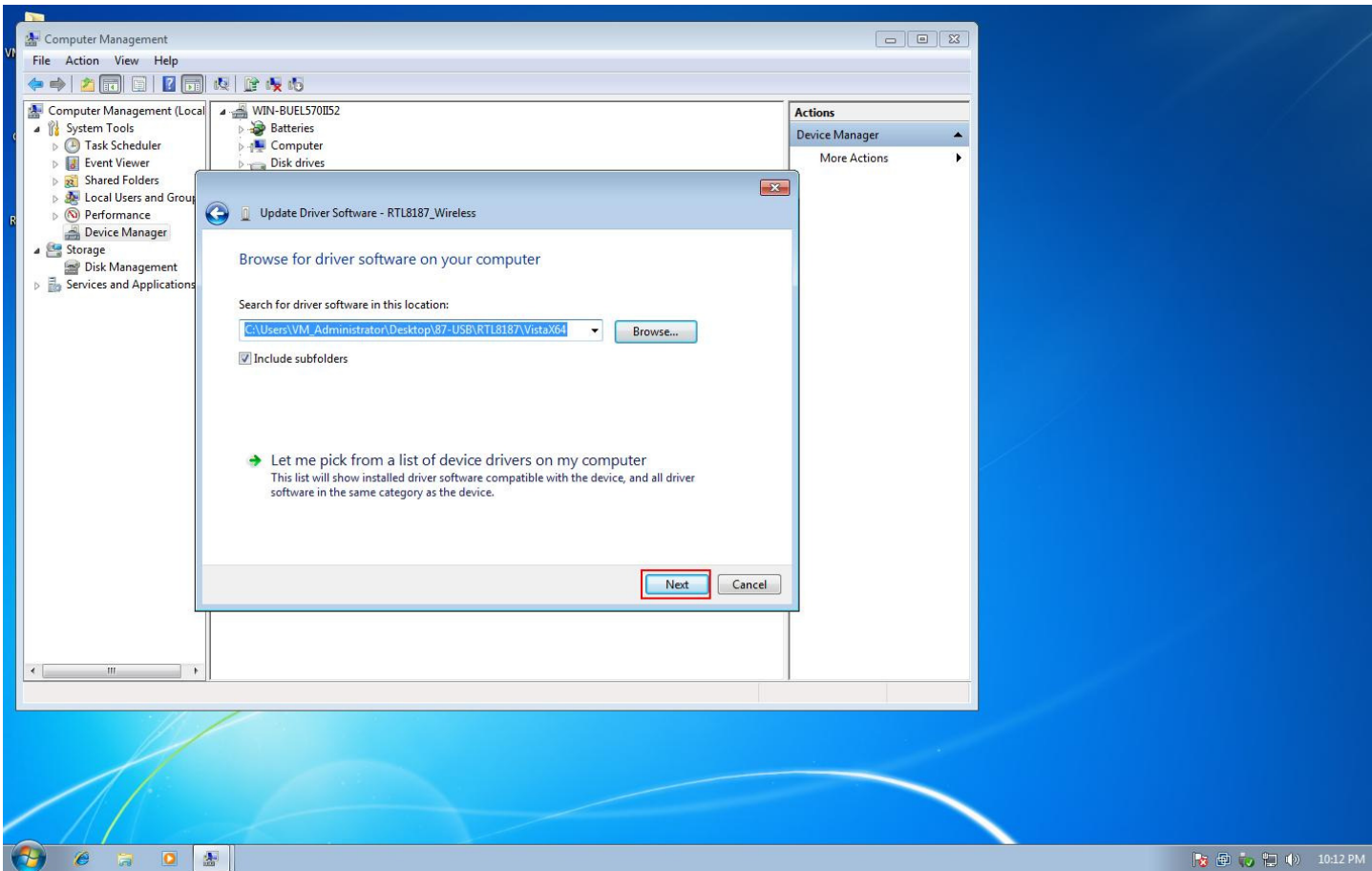
4. Update the device driver by pointing the driver folder that you have stored,



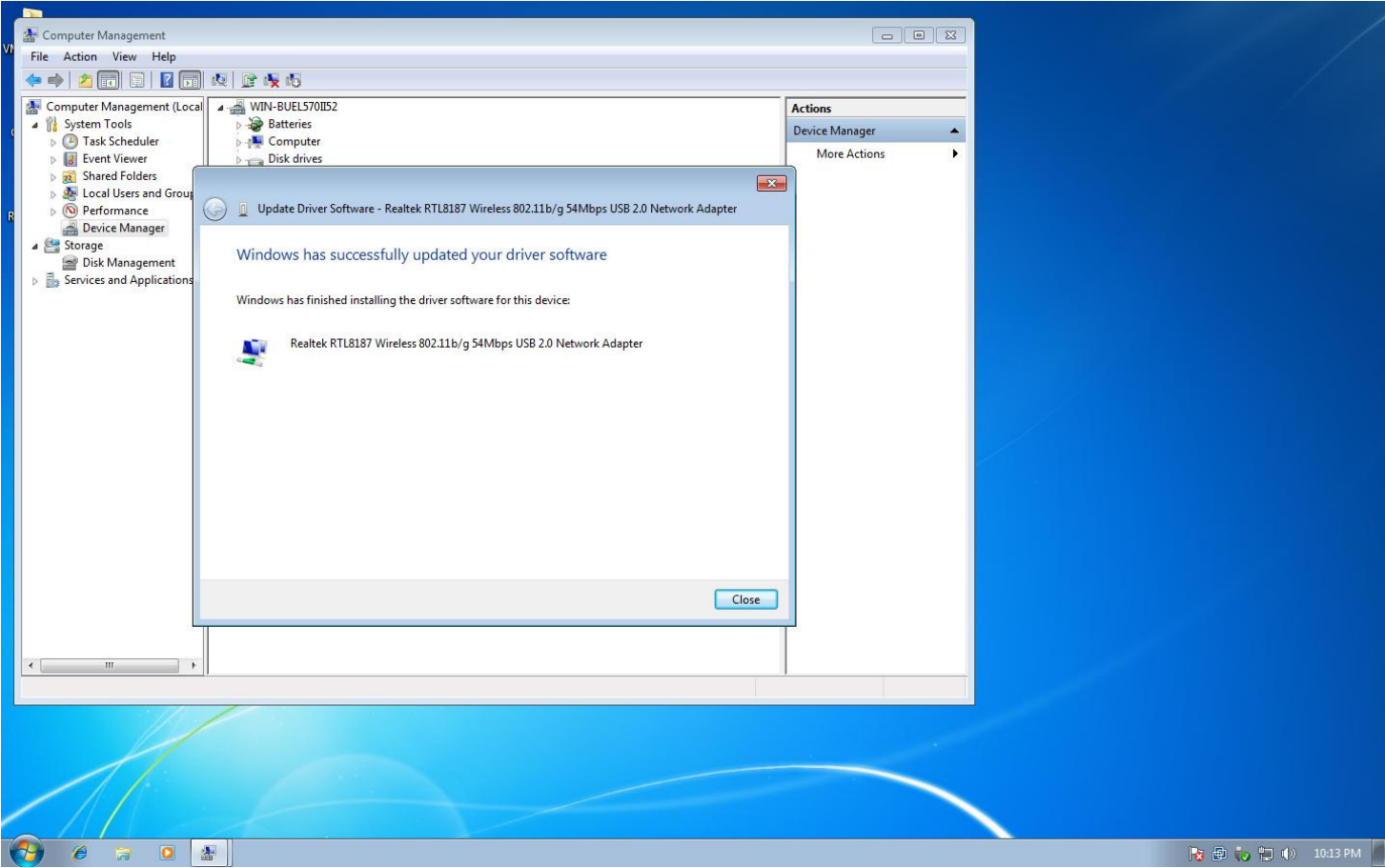
Select the proper driver folder (VistaX86 or VistaX64)



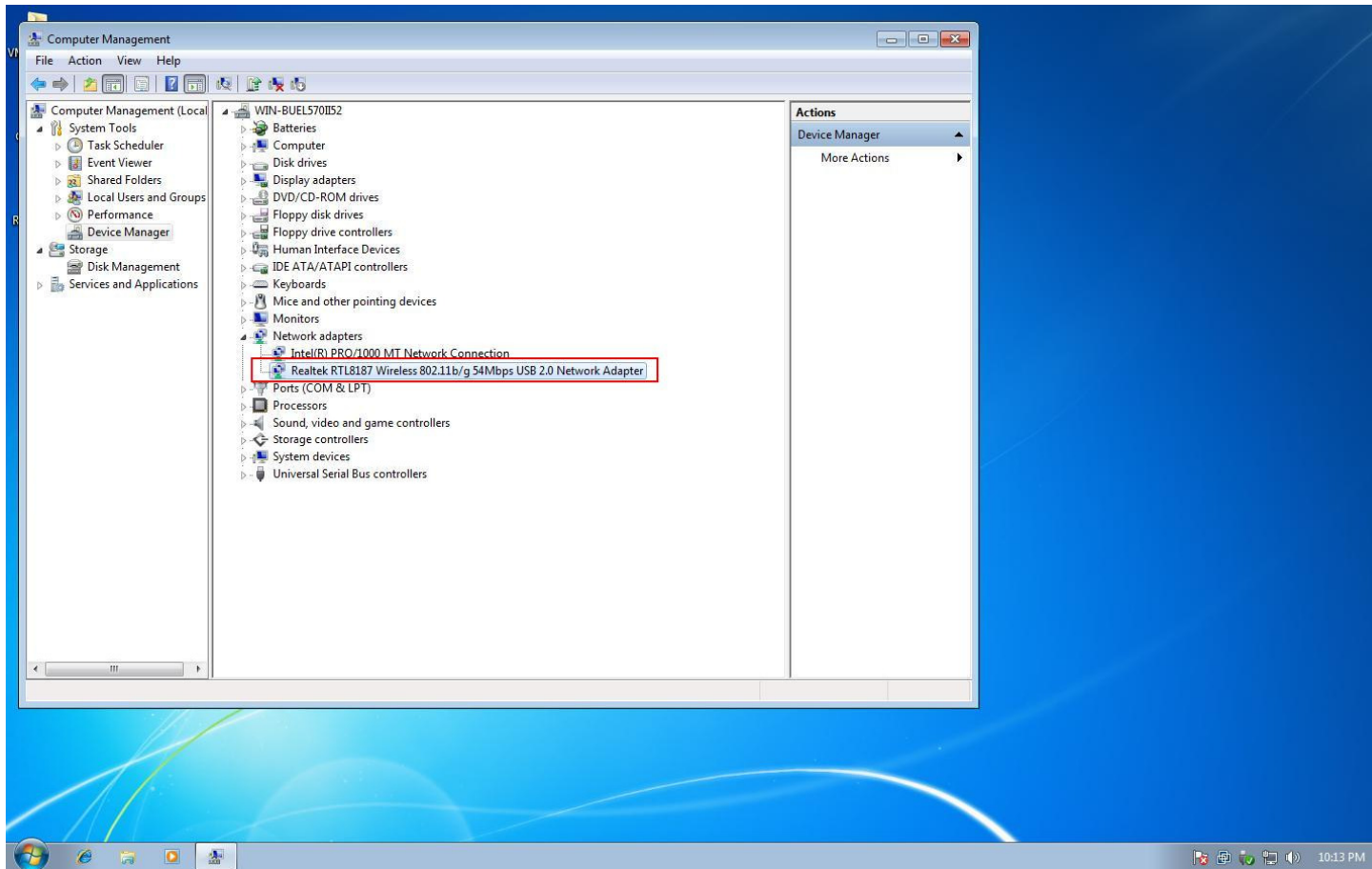
5. Click Next to begin driver installation.
